Notification – Central Station

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city's North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD and beyond to Bankstown in 2024 with new CBD metro railway stations at Martin Place, Pitt Street and Barangaroo and new metro platforms at Central. By 2030, Sydney will have four metro lines, with 46 stations and 113 kilometres of new metro rail.

Laing O'Rourke is delivering the new Sydney Metro platforms under Central Station as well as the landmark Central Walk - a new underground pedestrian concourse to help customers get around Sydney's busiest railway station.

Upcoming out of hours work at Central Station

While the majority of Central Station Metro works are now complete, some Sydney Metro work is continuing on Platforms 16 to 23. Work includes the releveling and retiling on platforms, as well as cladding and air conditioner replacement.

From 6pm Friday, 23 June, to 7am Monday, 26 June (around the clock), work will take place on Platforms 22-23. Some of the work may be noisy and will include platform surface excavation, grinding and saw cutting. Some sections of these platforms will reopen with the permanent tiles. On Platforms 20-21, sealing tiles will take place.

What to expect

- Machinery used during this weekend work will include excavators, tipper trucks, concreter and construction vehicles, hand and power tools including jackhammers and concrete saws.
- To follow a specific sequence during rail possessions weekend, there will be saw cutting activities overnight
 on Platforms 22-23 between Friday 23 June and Monday 26 June 2023.
- The majority of high noise impact activities would commence at 2am Saturday 24 June when the releveling
 works commence followed by intermittent use of concrete saws and jack hammers.
- Some work takes place at night or during weekend rail possessions for safety reasons or when trains are not running.

We appreciate that you may be affected by some noise coming from Central Station construction work as well as other project construction activities. The construction team has made every effort to minimise noise and has planned work during standard construction hours where possible.
