

# Notification – Luddenham

19 June 2023

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors and United Infrastructure Joint Venture (CPBUI JV) are completing the surface and civil alignment works contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport.

## Out-of-hours work:

- Some activities such as construction and utility works on busy roads must be carried out at night for the safety of workers and motorists.
- Installation of stormwater crossings across Luddenham Road to allow for the construction of a roundabout on Luddenham Road
- Construction of an access road from this roundabout to the future Luddenham Station
- The roundabout construction will be completed in the coming months.

## What to expect:


- Due to road and safety regulations, this work scope must be completed during night shifts, between the hours of **7pm to 5am**.
- This construction will commence in the week of Monday, 26 June 2023 for a period of eight weeks until the week ending Sunday, 20 August 2023
- Each week, there will be a maximum of **three-night shifts**, with **no more than two nights in a row** to minimise impact for our surrounding stakeholders. We will contact directly impacted residents regarding these works.
- To minimise the noise disruption of our neighbours, high impact work activities will include cutting of the road will occur **prior to 10pm**.
- Lighting towers will be positioned to minimise light spill for surrounding residents
- Increased vehicle movements on Luddenham Road
- Please refer to the map overleaf showing the work location.

## Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to hand tools, excavator, backhoe, trucks, vacuum truck, lighting towers, portable toilets, light and heavy vehicles.

## Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During the work, traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists safely around work areas. Access to driveways and buildings will be always maintained.
