Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

Quickway have been engaged to complete the watermain works for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport.

Out-of-hours work

Some work activities must be undertaken outside standard work hours in accordance with road occupancy approvals to minimise disruption to local traffic and ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians. The works will be carried out from 7am to 6pm between Monday 24 July to the end of August.

Out-of-hours working hours are 6pm-7am Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturday.

Work includes:

- Establishing a temporary work site
- Trenching and excavation along roadside
- Using machinery to cut into the road
- Installing temporary water mains
- Use of the Gipps Street compound for drop off and pick up of deliveries
- Restoring the work area, once complete.

What to expect

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- Noise from machinery and equipment
- No disruption to utility services.








Managing our impacts

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes

During these works, there may be some impacts to local roads including increased heavy vehicle movements. For the safety of road users, traffic control will be in place when required to assist with any changes to traffic conditions.
