No planned construction works will take place on this site during the Christmas break, from 23 December to 5 January inclusive. Landscape maintenance/watering will take place in the area during this period.

What to expect

- Temporary road and pedestrian access changes
- Traffic management, where required for the safety of workers and the community
- Access to any affected buildings or driveways will be maintained at all times
- Plant and vehicles used during this work may include excavators, hand tools, light vehicles, concrete trucks, cranes and other heavy vehicles.
