Monitoring status

- Real-time noise and vibration monitoring (with real-time access) ongoing at TSE, CSM, SSJ, NCW and Martin Place USP sites.
- Victoria Cross North vibration logger at 237 Miller St was relocated due to repeated vandalism. New location is adjacent to the acoustic shed, near 243 Miler St, on 14 October 2019.
- Crows Nest noise and vibration loggers at 10-12 Clarke St and 22 Clarke St removed on 25 October after completion of bulk excavation activities.
- Vibration logger attached to southern façade of 30-38 Chalmers prior to excavation commencing at the Bounce Hotel site.

Noise and vibration complaints

- Ongoing complaints about ground borne noise and vibration impacts from tunnelling activity. Dealt with appropriately by TSE.
- Noise and vibration complaints from all current TSE, CSM, MP-USP and Northern Corridor Works sites – dealt with appropriately by contractors.

Initiatives

• CSM successfully trialled installing a noise curtain "cover" over small high noise works area. To be implemented on a case-by-case basis if feasible and reasonable.
