There was one incident reported during this month wherein dirty water was leaving the project site boundary at Yard 15. However, no actual or potential material harm was observed. A non-compliance report (NCR002) was raised against CoA E65 "All reasonably practicable erosion and sediment controls must be installed and appropriately maintained to minimise any water pollution. When implementing such

	controls, any relevant guidance in the Managing Urban Stormwater Series must be considered".
