# **Key Construction Activities**

# Demolition and TSE

Works conducted in November 2017 at the following sites are summarised below:

#### **Chatswood:**

- Chatswood dive site (including the property boundary)
  - Utility, heritage and geotechnical investigations
  - Installation of HV and communications cables across the site for relocation away from dive excavation
  - o Removal and mulching of trees
  - Setting up offices and amenities including connecting services and fitting out existing buildings
  - Construction of internal site roads and driveways

#### Nelson Street

 Preparation and notification for relocation of underground utility services and temporarily reinstating the works areas. Temporary footpath parking lane closures proposed from 4 December 2017.

#### Out-of-hours works

- Installation of temporary pedestrian diversions and traffic controls to ensure the safety of pedestrians and traffic during the works
- Delivery and unloading of plant and equipment and establishing the works areas
- o Identification and inspection of underground utilities services and pits within the footpath and road
- Reinstating the excavated areas
- Trimming trees located within the site overhanging the footpath and Mowbray Road.
- Removal of one tree located on the footpath of Mowbray Road and one tree near the boundary of the site along Mowbray Road.
- Road condition inspections and testing carried out on Ellis Street, Gordon
   Avenue, Nelson Street, Mowbray Road, Hampden Road, Elizabeth Street and
   Brand Street before major construction works start at the Chatswood dive site

#### Artarmon:

Out of hours works - Road condition inspections and testing carried out on Reserve Road, Whiting Street, Dickson Avenue and Clarendon Street before major construction works start at the Artarmon substation site.

#### **Crows Nest:**

- Within and around the site
  - Completion of demolition of remaining buildings including 14 Clarke Street (Beaurepairs building)
  - Demolition of building slabs and installing retention to adjacent buildings where required
  - o Dismantling scaffolding and installing hoarding around the site perimeter
  - Continue identifying and relocating existing utility services such as power, gas, sewer and telecommunication lines around the perimeter of the Crows Nest Station site, along the Pacific Highway, Hume Street, Oxley Street and Willoughby Road

During the period, a tree identified incorrectly to be retained in Tree Report (Rev M) was removed at Chatswood. This tree was always intended for removal and the administrative oversight was corrected in the subsequent Tree Report endorsed on 4 December 2017. Sydney Metro and its contractors will continue to improve this interface to ensure that no future oversight occurs.
