Chatswood:

Tunnelling with both TBMs and spoil handling; various support activities

Chatswood NCW:

- Frank Channon Walk works included excavation and installation of a stormwater drainage system along the retaining wall; and excavation of material between the retaining walls and concrete batter.
- General activities at Brand Street included construction of soil nail wall; excavation and removal of spoil. Reduced works due to restrictions from start of Sydney Metro line and rain.

Artarmon Shaft:

No works occurring

- Breakthrough of TBM and traverse across the station box
