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#### Introduction

EMM Consulting Pty Limited (EMM) presents the November 2021 Noise and Vibration Report for the Sydney Metro City and Southwest project as required by SSI 15 7400 A27 (g) vi.

# Monitoring status

 Real-time noise and vibration monitoring (with real-time access) is ongoing at Barangaroo (noise only), VCISD, CSM (noise only), SSJ, MPISD, PSISD (noise only) and CNISD sites.

## Noise and vibration complaints

- Noise and vibration complaints from CNISD, VCISD, Barangaroo, PSISD, and WISD were received. These complaints were dealt with appropriately by contractors.
- Repeated noise complaints have been received from two separate receivers with respect to CNISD noise and specifically in relation to the night-time tower crane operation. The resolution of these complaints is an ongoing matter which is being managed by the contractor. As AA, we continue to monitor this matter closely in conjunction with Sydney Metro and providing ongoing advice to the contractor on additional feasible and reasonable noise mitigation and management measures and community consultation.

Based on a review of contractor performance throughout November and in consideration of the complaints received, one of the immediate actions taken was to withdraw the approval provided in the November OOHW10 application (version 12 dated 20 October 20121) for tower crane operation between 10pm and 12am for activities other than OSOM girder deliveries.

#### Initiatives

- Similar to October 2021, the focus this month as relatively new AAs on the project was to visit
  project sites as soon as possible to gain an understanding of what is occurring 'on-the-ground'
  and to meet key stakeholders.
- The new concrete pump enclosure installed at VCISD north site was inspected twice during November 2021. Our first inspection was during the regular ER inspection and the second was to observe noise levels during an initial concrete pour. Extended concrete pours at VCISD north site are proposed up until 10pm for up to three evenings per week and therefore this activity and feasible and reasonable noise mitigation has been comprehensively considered. Several additional measures, including modifications to the concrete pump exhaust to allow the pump to sit further inside the enclosure, and also the installation of noise blankets on 'noisy' sections of the concrete supply line were implemented in response to EMM's recommendations, with a material improvement achieved.

#### Non-compliances, incidents and events

• Incorrect settings on the PSISD contractor's sound level meter were observed which had a material influence on the recorded noise levels. This matter was raised as a non-conformance within the contractor's internal quality assurance systems. Corrective action was taken which included additional training of the team members involved.

# Ongoing and upcoming environmental risks

- OOH works, particularly long running concrete pours and/or oversize deliveries at ISD sites
  through December at WISD, VCISD and CNISD during extended working hours to catch up lost
  time due to construction pause and other impacts due to Covid.
- A 'watching brief' continues for ongoing OOH girder deliveries at CNISD. The risks associated
  with this activity have been discussed at length with the contractor and to ensure that all feasible
  and reasonable measures to mitigate and manage noise levels are duly considered and
  implemented. There is one more night of OOH girder deliveries for 2021 which are proposed for
  December 12. This will follow with several weeks of night-time respite for the community.

## Recommendations (incl auditing):

A project wide review of noise and vibration training of contractor staff who are involved with
noise and vibration prediction, management and measurement is recommended. This review
should also include verification of instrumentation settings. This is in response to recent
observations that have been made, most notably with respect to noise measurement practices
and instrumentation settings.
