## Inspections, audits and site visits

The following was undertaken:

- PSISD inspection with ER 3 May 2022 and 24 May 2022;
- WISD inspection with ER 12 May 2022;
- CNISD inspection with ER 11 May 2022; and
- CSM inspection with ER 11 May 2022 and 25 May 2022.

## Monitoring status

 Real-time noise and vibration monitoring (with real-time access) is ongoing at CNISD, VCISD Barangaroo, PSISD (noise only), MPISD and CSM.

The WISD Contractor is operating real-time noise monitors to assist with site noise management. This is not a requirement of their CNVMP and is optional only. We have access to this data on an as-needs basis only (eg when complaints are received).

## Noise and vibration complaints

- Noise complaints from Northern Connection (Chatswood), CNISD, VCISD, Barangaroo Station, PSISD, CSM and WISD were received, with most classified as unavoidable. Avoidable complaints were received at:
  - Northern Connection (Chatswood) due to an idling truck parked directly outside of a resident's house before 7am;
  - o PSISD due to a worker playing loud music; and
  - o CSM due to works outside of approved work hours in EPL OOH permit.

These complaints were dealt with appropriately by contractors by measures such as toolbox talks and reinforcement of mitigation and management measures.

- Two complaints are currently under investigation by the contractor at CNISD. One was due to
  works starting at 7am on a Saturday which are approved in the current OOH approval. Another
  was raised due to dogman shouting to communicate during an OOH girder delivery. The use of
  walkie talkies will be reinforced to minimise shouting in future deliveries.
- Two complaints are currently under investigation by the contractor at PSISD due to OOHW noise.
   The investigation was initiated to determine whether PSISD was generating the noise subject to compliant or if this was another project in the vicinity.

#### Initiatives

• We have continued to request attended noise monitoring records on a regular basis to verify that the appropriate level of information is being recorded by noise monitoring personnel and overall adherence to CNVMP and NMP requirements.

#### Non-compliances, incidents and events

# Ongoing and upcoming environmental risks

- At Barangaroo, high noise works including the demolition of Hickson Road will be occurring over the coming months during standard construction hours.
- Ongoing OOH utility works at WISD.
- OOH works, particularly long running concrete pours and/or oversize deliveries at ISD sites at WISD, VCISD and CNISD will continue.
- A significant phase of utilities works will continue at PSISD. OOHW is required due to ROL requirements and footpath permits from Council.

Capping beam removal will continue at WISD during standard construction hours. The initial
methodology of 40t excavator and hydraulic rock breaker attachment was scrutinised heavily by
ER and AA and the contractor was requested to review other methodologies. WISD now propose
to utilise a combination of 40t excavator and hydraulic rock breaker attachment in some areas
and a wire saw and core drilling (consistent with successful removal of capping beam at PSISD)
in other areas for capping beam removal. The CNVIS and CNVMP were updated to incorporate
these works and endorsed.
