Inspections, audits and site visits

The following was done:

- WISD inspection with ER 3 June 2022;
- MPISD inspection with ER 3 June 2022 and 25 May 2022;
- CNISD inspection with ER 15 June 2022; and
- PSISD inspection with ER 21 June 2022.

Monitoring status

 Real-time noise and vibration monitoring (with real-time access) is ongoing at CNISD, VCISD Barangaroo, PSISD (noise only), MPISD and CSM.

The WISD Contractor is operating real-time noise monitors to assist with site noise management. This is not a requirement of their CNVMP and is optional only. We have access to this data on an as-needs basis only (eg when complaints are received).

Noise and vibration complaints

- Noise complaints from CNISD (x1), VCISD (x2), PSISD (x2), Surry Hills (x1) and WISD (x2) were
 received, with most classified as unavoidable. Avoidable complaints were received at:
 - Surry Hills due to the early delivery of equipment prior to the approved start time;
 - VCISD due to worker behaviour; and
 - PSISD due to a concrete pour starting before 7am without approval.

These complaints were or will be dealt with appropriately by contractors by measures such as toolbox talks and reinforcement of mitigation and management measures.

Initiatives

We have continued to request attended noise monitoring records on a regular basis to verify that
the appropriate level of information is being recorded by noise monitoring personnel and overall
adherence to CNVMP and NMP requirements.

Non-compliances, incidents and events

 A non-conformance report was raised by the contractor at PSISD for the early morning concrete pour that occurred without formal approval.

Ongoing and upcoming environmental risks

- At Barangaroo, high noise works including the demolition of Hickson Road will be occurring over the coming months during standard construction hours.
- Ongoing OOH utility works at WISD.
- OOH works, particularly long running concrete pours and/or oversize deliveries at ISD sites at WISD, VCISD and CNISD will continue.
- A significant phase of utilities works will continue at PSISD and WISD. OOHW is required due to ROL requirements and footpath permits from Council.
- Capping beam removal will continue at WISD during standard construction hours. The initial
 methodology of 40t excavator and hydraulic rock breaker attachment was scrutinised heavily by
 ER and AA and the contractor was requested to review other methodologies. WISD now propose
 to utilise a combination of 40t excavator and hydraulic rock breaker attachment in some areas
 and a wire saw and core drilling (consistent with successful removal of capping beam at PSISD)

in other areas for capping beam removal. The CNVIS and CNVMP were updated to incorporate these works and have now been endorsed.

- Several ISDs are now approaching or are at ground level with noise levels increasing and works being more visible to the community and nearest noise-sensitive receivers. This increases the risk of noise impacts and complaints and will be monitored closely.
- OSOM OOH girder deliveries will be occurring at CNISD throughout July.
