Inspections, audits and site visits

The following was complete:

- LWW inspection at Northern sites with ER on 1 November 2022;
- WISD inspection with ER on 3 November 2022;
- CSM inspection with ER on 9 November 2022;
- PSISD inspection with ER on 15 November 2022;
- CNSID inspection with ER on 16 November 2022;
- Barangaroo inspection with ER on 17 November 2022; and
- Barangaroo night-time site inspection of Hickson Rd stormwater works on 21 November 2022.

Monitoring status

Real-time noise and vibration monitoring (with real-time access) is ongoing at CNISD, VCISD (noise only), Barangaroo, PSISD (noise only), MPISD and CSM.

The WISD Contractor is operating real-time noise monitors to assist with site noise management. This is not a requirement of their CNVMP and is optional only. We have access to this data on an as-needs basis only (eg when complaints are received).

Noise and vibration complaints

Complaints from Barangaroo (x2), CNISD (x8), MPISD (x1), PSISD (x5), LWW Surry Hills Power Upgrade Belmore Street (x3), VCISD (x3) and WISD (x1) were received. Most complaints were classified as unavoidable (15 of 23). At the time of writing the report four complaints (Barangaroo (x2), CNISD (x1) and PSISD (x1)) were under investigation by Contractors and/or Sydney Metro. The avoidable complaints were in relation to:

- Three complaints were received from residents near LWW Surry Hills Power Upgrade Belmore Street which were triggered by a stationary security vehicle idling during early hours of the morning. As a result of the repeat occurrences the security contractor was dismissed. A new security contractor has been engaged and briefed in detail with respect to the noise responsibilities at the site.
- Construction activity prior to 7am on Saturday morning triggered a complaint at VCISD North site. The contractor has since workshopped this with the construction team and reinforced

expectations around work practices during sensitive time periods and the weekend start time of 7am.

Initiatives, continual improvement and feedback

- We continue to advocate the use of alternative work practices to rock hammering for the removal of temporary structures. Capping beam removal using a wire saw continued at WISD and commenced at CNISD. VCISD is currently exploring this as an option for the capping beam demolition for the north site.
- WISD contractors are being highly proactive with the community in terms of information sharing and engagement with several events and initiatives being undertaken through November and December 2022. Furthermore, careful planning of work locations and timing is being implemented, with a two-week calendar look ahead advocated by AA and ER and being implemented by the contractor to provide greater visibility of times and locations of OOHW to the AA and ER.

Non-compliances, incidents and events

- A joint NCR (LWW NCR-018) was raised for the repeated issue of light vehicles idling at Belmore Street, Surry Hills by SC/LWW.
- An NCR (NCR-09) was raised at VCISD (south site) for works starting prior to 7am on two separate occasions. Both instances triggered complaints from residents in 79-81 Berry Street, North Sydney.

Ongoing and upcoming environmental risks

- OOH works, particularly long running concrete pours and/or oversize deliveries at ISD sites at WISD, PSISD, VCISD and CNISD will continue. There is anticipated to be no more long running concrete pours for WISD.
- A significant phase of utilities works will continue at PSISD and WISD. OOHW is required due to ROL requirements and footpath permits from Council.
- Public domain works have started at CNISD and will continue for several months. This will require a substantial scope of utilities works of which some will be required OOH to facilitate utility service provider requirements.
- Capping beam removal will continue at WISD and CNISD during standard construction hours. The alternative lower noise method of wire saw and core drilling (consistent with successful removal of capping beam at PSISD) is being used where feasible and has proved to provide additional benefits in terms of dust suppression and smaller exclusion zones on site. The WISD contractor has also demonstrated that capping beam removal with wire saw can occur at discrete locations of the site during the evening hours (NML compliant) with the activities subject to verification measurements.
