

November	Project wide The AA team presented a briefing at toolbox talks across the project on good practice in implementation of temporary noise barriers. The focus on temporary noise barriers follows comments raised by EPA during their OOH surveillance earlier in the year (although their comments weren't specifically focussed on Sydney Metro).	

## Noise and vibration complaints

15 noise and vibration complaints during November (45% of total complaints received).

5 of the complaints related to GLC works at Westmead, 5 related to AFJV works at Five Dock (including 3 from the resident whose case was escalated to the Community Complaints Mediator), 4 related to AFJV works at Sydney Olympic Park and 1 from GLC works at Parramatta.

Note: The chart shows noise and vibration (NV) complaints in standard hours and out of hours (OOH) periods. Some complaints relate to both time periods so the total number of NV complaints may be less than the sum of standard and OOH complaints.



## Ongoing and upcoming noise and vibration risks

- Ongoing activity at AFJV sites, including OOH work, particularly around coordination with others to ensure respite is provided. Joint meetings are being held for coordination of works, and joint notifications are being prepared.
- Upcoming permanent pavement installation at Rozelle by Quickway, which triggers large numbers of Alternate Accommodation offers, and may take place over the Christmas period.
- Ongoing construction near to the horse stables at Rosehill Gardens.
- OOH trenching work between Westmead and Parramatta.
