# Notification – out-of-hours relocation of heavy machinery

# March 2024

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A cityshaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the Western Sydney Aerotropolis in the south with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors and United Infrastructure Joint Venture (CPBUI JV) are completing the surface and civil alignment works contract for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport.

## Out-of-hours work:

We will be relocating heavy machinery from Cosgrove Creek, Luddenham to Blaxland Creek, Orchard Hills. The out-of-hours work will be carried out between **8pm** and **5am** for up to **three nights** between **Tuesday 19 March 2024** and **Friday 29 March 2024**, weather depending. Work will also take place during standard construction hours **Monday** to **Friday**, **7am** to **6pm** and **Saturday**, **8am** to **1pm** during this time.

It is essential to carry out this work outside of standard construction hours to minimise impact and safety risks on the local community, road users and our workers. Please follow the directions of signs and Traffic Control.

## Work will include:

- Operation of heavy and light vehicles
- Temporary lane closure with detours in place
- Restoration of the area upon completion.

## What to expect:

- To complete the work safely, a road closure with detours will be in place on Luddenham Road between Twin Creeks and Mamre Road
- Traffic Control will be onsite to ensure emergency services and local traffic can still access Luddenham Road
- Heavy vehicles will be in use to relocate the heavy machinery with the assistance of light escort vehicles.

# Equipment used:

Equipment for this work includes but is not limited to heavy vehicles, lighting towers, traffic control, light and heavy vehicles.
