What work are we doing?

During June, our work activities will include:

- · Adjusting construction hoarding
- Removing materials from work areas
- Removing materials from our laydown areas on Hobart Street and Harris Street
- Electrical work on all platforms
- Piling work on all platforms including concreting work
- Delivering materials to our work areas.

When and where we'll be working

Standard working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday** to **Friday and 7am** to **1pm, Saturday.** Our work and laydown areas are shown on the map on the next page.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- An increase in workers and vehicles around our work and laydown areas.
- Workers on all platforms to continue piling
- Traffic control and work signs as required
- Some noise and vibration from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. Our work areas are designed to minimise impact.

This includes:

- Installing fencing for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible.

Equipment

Equipment to be used includes piling rigs, drills, demolition saws, excavators, saw cutters, dump trucks, front end loaders, vacuum trucks, semi-trailers and rigid trucks, concrete trucks, mobile crane, light towers, power tools, survey equipment and hand tools.
