Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferrovial Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV is undertaking line marking work on Waterview Street, Second Avenue and Great North Road. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, workers and local businesses.

The line marking will be carried out **between 8pm and 5am on Monday 1 July 2024** starting from Waterview Street and finishing at Great North Road (weather and site conditions permitting). The contingency night is Tuesday 2 July 2024.

The work will include:

- Setting up traffic control
- Removing existing line markings on Waterview Street, Second Avenue and Great North Road
- Minor road modifications, resurfacing and asphalting prior to line marking
- Marking sections on the three roads using a line marking machine

What to expect:

- There will be noise associated with this work, but we will try to minimise this as much as possible
- The work is expected to take up to 8 hours.
- Lighting will be directed to the work areas and away from residential properties

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:


- Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes at the work locations
- Lane and footpath closures on Waterview Street, Second Avenue and Great North Road
- Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times
- Access to residential properties will be maintained during the work
