# **Station Boxes and Tunnelling**

20 June 2024

Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport is the new metro railway line which will service Greater Western Sydney and the new Western Sydney International (Nancy-Bird Walton) Airport. A city-shaping project, the 23-kilometre new railway will connect the new Western Sydney Bradfield City Centre in the south, with St Marys in the north – where customers can connect to the existing Sydney Trains suburban T1 Western Line. The NSW and Australian governments have a shared objective of having Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport operational when the airport opens for passenger services.

CPB Contractors Ghella are delivering the Station Boxes and Tunnelling (SBT) works for Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport.

### Out-of-hours work

The project's standard construction hours are **Monday** to **Friday 7am** to **6pm** and **Saturday 8am** to **1pm**. Most work is carried out between these hours, however some work activities including tunnelling and tunnel support may be carried out after-hours to mitigate quality and safety risks. This is in accordance with the project Environment Protection Licence (EPL), Conditions of Approval, Road Occupancy Licences, and Transport for NSW requirements.

Concrete deliveries and concrete pours during extended hours will start on **Thursday 27 June 2024** and be carried out for **six months, 24 hours a day, seven days a week**. This work is to support cross passage construction from the Bringelly shaft.

# What to expect:

- Work activities will generate noise impacts above background levels. Mitigation measures will be implemented to minimise noise emissions, including noise blankets. Additional verification monitoring will also be undertaken to ensure noise levels are within predicted levels.
- Increased work and vehicle movements in and around the work site during the extended hours.

# Equipment used:

Includes (but is not limited to) concrete agitators, concrete pumps, mobile cranes, air compressors, heavy and light vehicles, lighting towers, powered hand tools and traffic control devices.

## Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

During these works, traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow and stop-slow traffic controls. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals. Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times. Residents will be separately notified if access to driveways will be affected or access to private property is requested.

# Changes to traffic, pedestrian, and cyclist routes:

During these works, traffic control will be in place to assist motorist, pedestrians, and cyclists with any changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow and stop-slow traffic controls. The times of these changes will vary and are dependent on road authority approvals. Access to driveways and buildings will be maintained at all times.
