

Project update – Victoria Cross

June 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia’s biggest public transport project.

Services started in May 2019 in the city’s North West with a train every four minutes in the peak. Metro rail will be extended into the CBD in 2024, with new metro railway stations at Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place, Gadigal and Waterloo, and new metro platforms at Central, and then onto Bankstown in 2025.

Lendlease will deliver the new Sydney Metro Victoria Cross integrated station development at North Sydney, including the metro station, over station development (OSD) and enhancements to pedestrian connections, retail and public spaces.

What work are we doing?

Upcoming work – McLaren and Miller streets intersection

Below is an indicative table of activities scheduled at the intersection of McLaren and Miller streets. Works are planned to take place between 24 June 2024 to 27 July 2024, weather permitting. Each location will take up to 10 days of work.

What to expect

- Traffic and pedestrian changes to surrounding streets. Access to buildings and driveways will always be maintained.
- Traffic control and directional signage will be in place for the safety of workers, pedestrians and the community. A specific pedestrian management plan will be implemented during school arrival and departure times.
- Some of these activities will be noisy. The project team will limit these impacts where possible. Non-tonal reversing beepers will be used. Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum.
