



Notification - Clyde and surrounds

3 July 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Temporary removal of street parking on Grand Avenue and Colquhoun Street – July-August 2024

Tunnelling contractor, GLC will continue out-of-hours delivery of oversized machinery to the site on Unwin Street, Clyde. Due to the size of some deliveries temporary removal of street parking on Grand Avenue and Colquhoun Street will be required **between 5pm and 4am each night** from **Wednesday 10 July to Monday 29 July 2024**, see the map overleaf for locations.

Deliveries are planned to continue until late August 2024. We will update you again as the delivery schedule progresses or if there are any changes.

In the event that vehicles are parked on the delivery route, owners of the vehicle will be contacted by Police and the vehicles towed to a nearby parking spot in the area. For more information, contact the community team on 1800 612 173 or metrotunnelsGLC@transport.nsw.gov.au.

Out of hours deliveries

Out-of-hours deliveries are planned to minimise interruption to local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers around the site.


The deliveries are in line with Road Occupancy Licence and Transport for NSW requirements for the movement of oversized vehicles.

What to expect:

- Some activities will generate noise and this will be minimised as much as possible
- Lights used during deliveries will be directed to the work areas and away from businesses
- Access to property and businesses will be maintained at all times
- Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions. This may include contraflow and stop-slow traffic control
- Allow extra time when travelling near these areas.

Equipment used: (but is not limited to) hand tools, heavy vehicles, cranes, generators, tow trucks, lighting towers, forklifts, light vehicles and traffic control devices.
