



Notification - Clyde and surrounds

13 August 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West –a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Temporary removal of parking planned for Wentworth Street – 19-24 August, 26-29 August 2024

For the delivery of oversized bridge beams, temporary removal of parking along a section of both sides of Wentworth Street will be in place from:

- 4pm to 5am Monday 19 August to Saturday 24 August 2024.
- 4pm to 5am Monday 26 August to Thursday 29 August 2024.

Temporary road closure planned for Unwin and Wentworth Streets - 26-29 August 2024

For the installation of oversized bridge beams adjacent, sections of Unwin and Wentworth Street will be closed from 10pm to 5am Monday 26 August to Thursday 29 August 2024.

The planned road closure will be between the intersection of Wentworth and Martha Streets and the intersection of Shirley and Unwin Street, see map overleaf for details.

Access for vehicles will be maintained via the detours outlined below:

Entry and exit to the industrial area will only be via Grand Avenue from James Ruse Drive.

Detour from the intersection of Wentworth Street and Martha Street - Vehicles travelling northbound on Wentworth Street will detour via Martha Street using Parramatta Road in both directions.

Detour from the intersection of Unwin Street and Shirley Street - Vehicles travelling westbound on Unwin Street will detour via Colquhoun Street and Grand Avenue to James Ruse Drive in both directions.

Traffic management and signage will be in place. Please keep to speed limits and follow the detours.

Works will involve:

- Setting up of detours and traffic management, VMS signage, temporary removal of parking.
- Delivering oversize bridge beams to Unwin Street.
- Setting up a crane on Unwin Street to lift the bridge beams into place.
- Demobilising the crane and restoring the area each morning when the road reopens.

What to expect

- Some activities will generate noise and this will be minimised as much as possible.
- Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Traffic control and signage to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions will be in place.

Allow extra time when travelling near these areas.

Detour map


