Notification – Temporary road closure

19 August 2024

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

John Holland CPB Contractors Ghella Joint Venture (JCG) has been awarded the contract to deliver 3.5 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Hunter Street and to excavate the Pyrmont and Hunter Street metro stations.

Temporary road closure

Pyrmont Bridge Road will be temporarily closed in both directions between Pyrmont Street and Union Street from **7pm Saturday 31 August until 4am Monday 2 September***. This closure is required for the demobilisation of the tower crane at Pyrmont East.

Vehicle and pedestrian access will be closed. Little Edward Street and Harwood Street will remain open with access via Edward Lane and Bunn Street. Traffic management will be in place for the duration of the closure to assist vehicles and pedestrians. Temporary parking removal along the detour will be in place.

This work is subject to site and weather conditions and will be rescheduled to the next available shift if required.

*Contingency dates are planned for Saturday 7 September and Sunday 8 September.

Out-of-hours deliveries

Ahead of tower crane demobilisation, we'll need to work out of hours using the tower crane to facilitate oversized deliveries and move equipment and machinery. Work will take place from 6pm and 6am, between Monday 26 and Friday 30 August.

What will this mean for you?

During work, you may notice:

- Installation of traffic and pedestrian controls ahead of temporary road closure
- Temporary road and footpath closure on Pyrmont Bridge Road
- Using equipment such as hand tools including rattle guns
- Periods of increased noise
- Delivery of materials, plant and equipment
- Traffic and pedestrian management
- Temporary parking removal







Equipment and machinery used

May include but is not limited to traffic control equipment, small and medium cranes, vehicles, rattle guns, hoist and hand tools.
