

Monthly update – Parramatta

23 August 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Construction activities: September 2024

Tunnelling contractor, GLC will continue major construction at the Parramatta metro station site during September. These activities will be carried out during standard construction hours:

- **Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 8am to 6pm**

Work will involve:

- Archaeological investigations and backfilling of areas once complete.
- Removing concrete sections and piles in stages with saw cutters and jackhammers.
- Delivering and removing machinery, equipment, and materials via George Street.
- Constructing and excavating the tunnel nozzles and future station box including rock hammering, concreting, steel bracing installation and support work.
- Geotechnical investigations and utility investigations and upgrades within and around site.
- Ongoing surveying within and around the site.
- Aerial drone filming on-site. This will be in line with Civil Aviation Safety Authority guidelines.

Out-of-hours work

To minimise interruption to local traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers around the site, some work must be undertaken outside standard construction hours.

Out-of-hours work will involve:

- Tunnel nozzle excavation and support works within the station box **24 hours a day, Monday to Sunday** until January 2025.
- Spoil removal (excavated material), oversized machinery and equipment deliveries to the site between **6pm and 7am from Sunday 1 September to Monday 30 September 2024**.
- Geotechnical investigations between Marsden and Church Street between **6pm and 7am from Sunday to Thursday has been extended until late September 2024** due to program rescheduling, see map for details.

We will continue to keep you informed of our progress and planned out-of-hours work. To know more, register your details to receive weekly email updates at metrotunnelsGLC@transport.nsw.gov.au.

Out-of-hours activities are in line with Road Occupancy Licences; and Transport for NSW requirements to work in the road corridor and for the movement of oversized vehicles.

What to expect

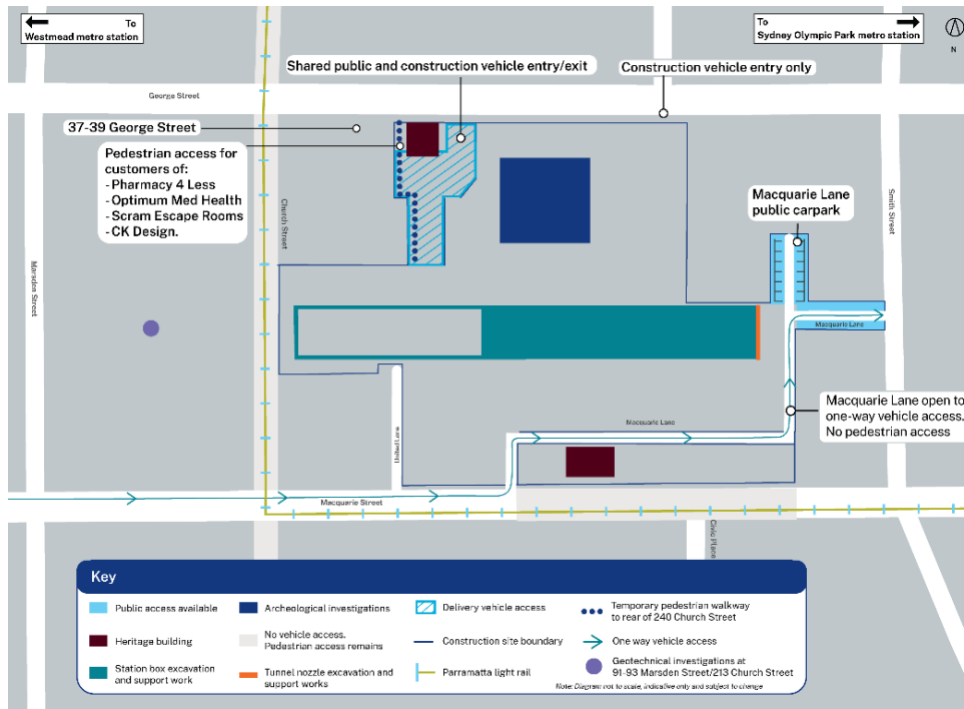
- Some activities will generate noise and vibration, but this will be minimised as much as possible.
- Access to businesses will be maintained unless arrangements are made with you in advance.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes

- Temporary signage and traffic control to assist motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions. Allow some extra time for your journey when travelling near these areas.

Equipment used: Equipment for this work will include but is not limited to hand tools, cranes, generators, truck and dogs, survey equipment, light vehicles, drill rigs, excavators, rock hammer, dozers, vibratory rollers and compactors, concrete agitators, vacuum excavation trucks, tipper trucks, delivery vehicles, fencing, road saw and traffic control devices.
