Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock.

Out-of-hours work at The Bays

As part of site demobilisation works, Central Tunnelling Package (CTP) contractor AFJV, is **decommissioning underground utilities and restoring the road on Robert Street, Rozelle**. This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions, to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, workers and local businesses.

The out-of-hours work will be carried out **between 6pm and 5am on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday nights from Monday 21 October up to and including Thursday 31 October 2024** (weather and site conditions permitting). Monday 4, Tuesday 5, and Thursday 7 November 2024 may be used as contingency night shifts, as required.

The work will include:

- Saw cutting surface material (concrete/bitumen) to open the trench
- Excavating and removing material
- Disconnecting the utilities
- Restoring the impacted areas.

What to expect:

- Noise blankets will be used for work along Robert Street to minimise disturbance
- Saw cutting work along Robert Street will be completed by 12am
- Two-way traffic will be maintained on Robert Street at all times but there may be minor delays
- Noise monitoring will be carried out to confirm predicted noise levels at nearest residences
- There will be no planned disruption to the supply of utility services to residences

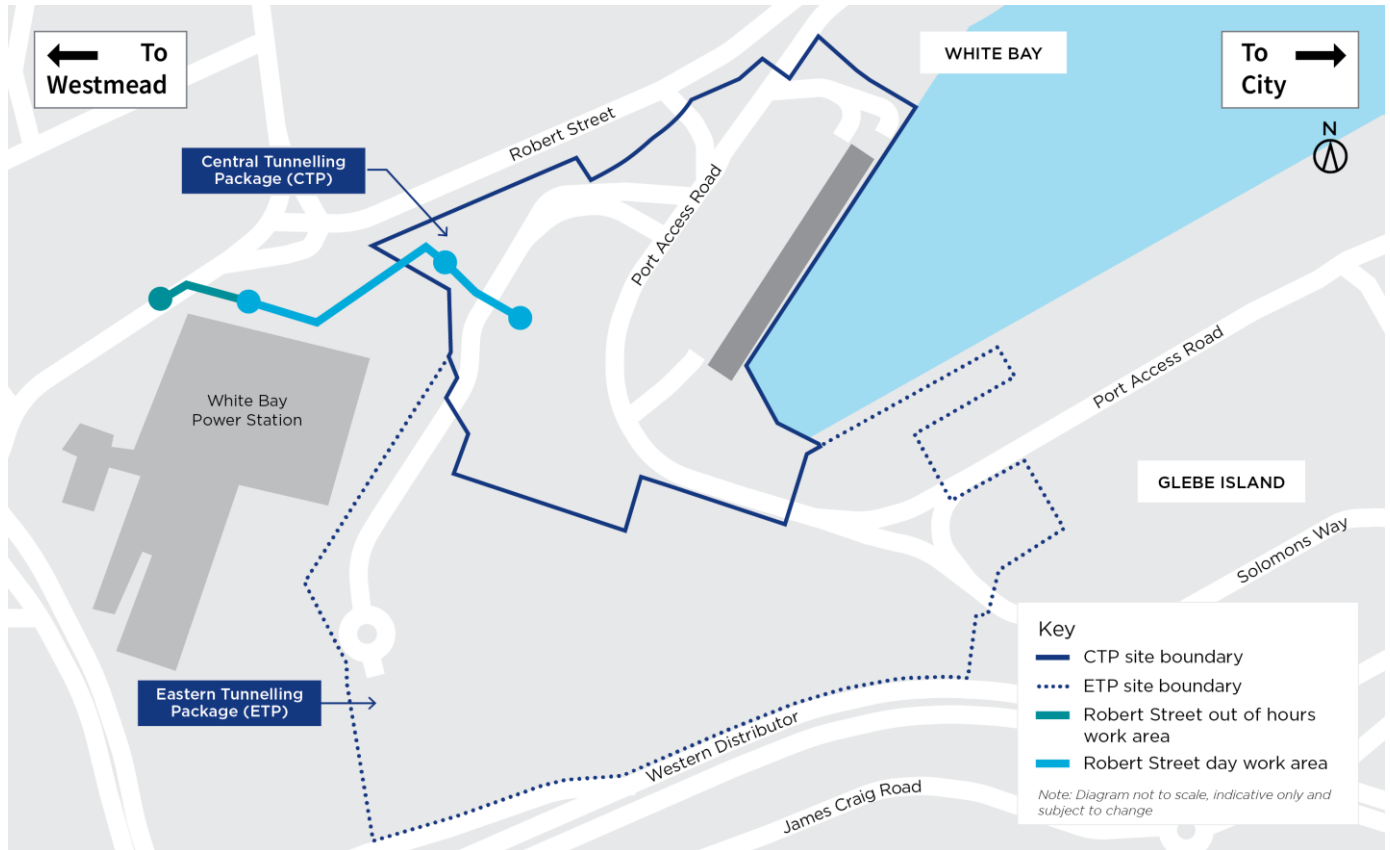
Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes to traffic conditions including partial road and footpath closures on the southern side of Robert Street.

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: road/concrete saws, excavators with hammer attachments, trucks, vacuum truck, wacker packer, plate compactor, trench roller, concrete vibrator, concrete truck, concrete pump, jackhammer, generator, light vehicles, light towers and electric hand tools
