

Notification – St Marys Station footbridge

November 2024

Transport for NSW is delivering a new footbridge and northern plaza at St Marys Station as part of the Sydney Metro – Western Sydney Airport project

What work are we doing?

During **November**, work activities will include:

- removing and delivering materials and equipment to and from our work and laydown areas
- removing a crane from the Harris Street work area, requiring around four parking spaces to be temporarily unavailable for one day on 1 November
- electrical work on all platforms
- excavation and concrete work on all platforms
- excavation, piling and concrete work within the site compound on Harris Street
- utility service investigation work on Harris Street and around the multi-storey car park.

Weekend work in November:

In November, some work will take place continuously during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekends. Weekend work will occur from **1am Saturday 16 November** until **1am Monday 18 November**. Activities during these weekends include:

- removing and delivering materials
- concreting and excavation work
- electrical work.

What to expect:

- An increase in workers and vehicles around work sites and laydown areas, and on the station platforms, especially during our weekend work
- Traffic control and signage as required
- There will be an increase in noise and vibration from construction machinery and equipment operating behind the construction hoarding on all platforms.

Managing our impacts:

We aim to manage work taking place to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This site compound is designed to minimise impact.

This includes:

- installing fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off machinery when not in use and using temporary noise barriers where feasible.

Equipment to be used:

Equipment includes piling rigs, drills, demolition saws, excavators, saw cutters, dump trucks, front end loaders, vacuum trucks, semi-trailers and rigid trucks, concrete pumps, concrete trucks, mobile crane, light towers, power tools, survey equipment and hand tools.

Planned work outside of standard hours over the next three months:

Work activities including excavation, piling, concrete work, electrical work and removal of materials are planned for the following weekends (subject to approval):

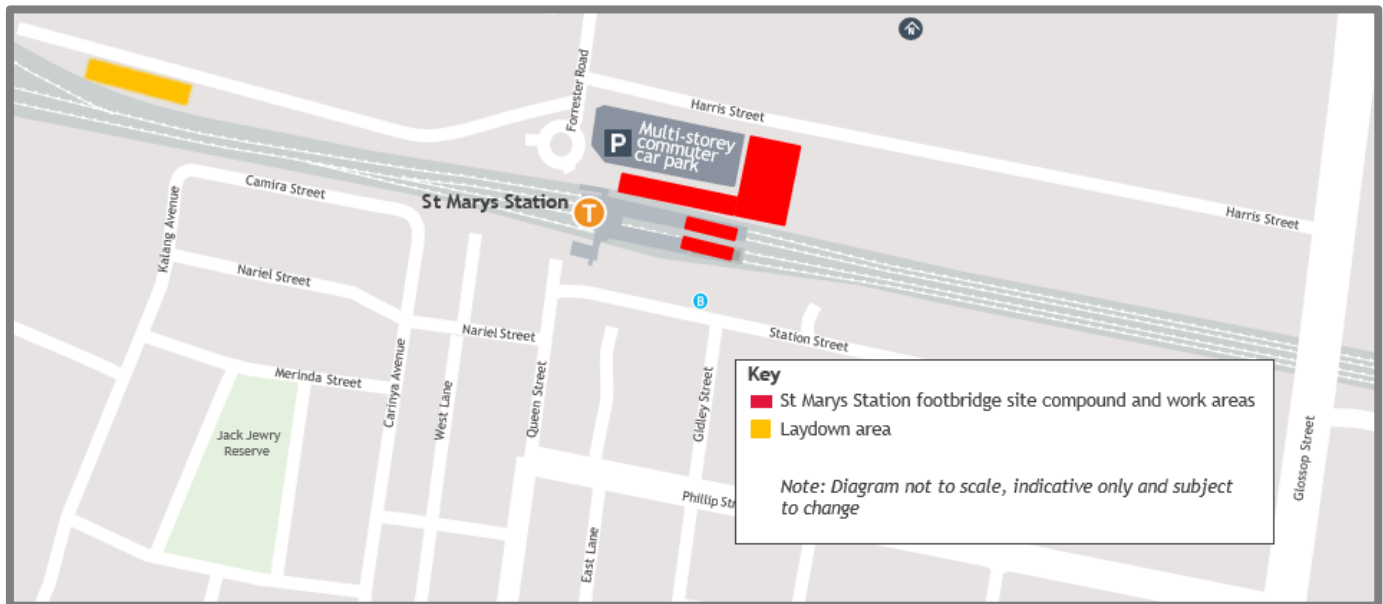
- **1am Saturday 16 November** until **1am Monday 18 November**
- **1am Saturday 14 December** until **1am Monday 16 December 2024**
- **1am Saturday 11 January** until **1am Monday 13 January 2025**

When and where we'll be working:

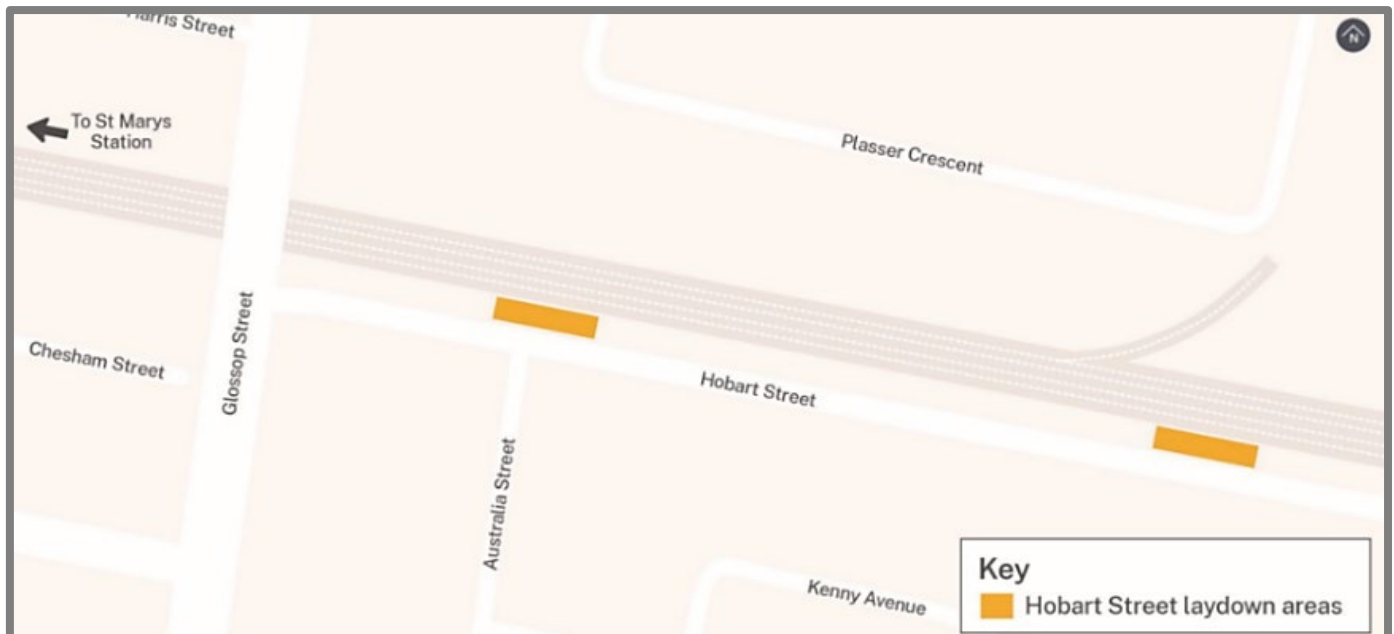
