

Monthly update – Burwood North

29 November 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including Burwood North Station.

Work during December

Work will continue within and around the northern station box during December. This will include:

- Delivery of reinforcement, formwork and concrete for the plenum structure within the cavern
- Delivery of concrete for construction of the tunnel invert slab
- Cross passage construction
- Utility work on Burwood and Parramatta roads
- Installation, adjustment and removal of fencing, scaffolding and hoarding
- Demobilisation of site facilities on the northern construction site including the acoustic shed
- Delivery and pick up of oversized equipment to and from the northern site

This work will be carried out during standard construction hours:

- Monday to Friday 7am – 6pm and Saturday 8am – 6pm

Christmas shut down

While most of the project will shut down over the Christmas and New Year period, from **Friday 20 December 2024** to **Monday 6 January 2025**, critical tunnelling related activities will continue to be carried out 24 hours a day, except on 25 and 26 December 2024 and 1 January 2025.

Equipment used

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: trucks, light vehicles, excavator with hammer attachment, generators, watercarts, concrete trucks, compaction plate, concrete saws, bobcats, multi service vehicles, elevated work platforms, jack hammers, lighting towers, vacuum trucks, paving machines, concrete pumps and hand tools.

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists at entry and exit points to the construction site. The road restoration and utility work taking place in the surrounding streets will require some temporary footpath closures and road detours. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist motorists around this work. Material removal and delivery may be undertaken from the northern construction site using driveways located on Parramatta Road as well as Burton and Loftus streets between 7am and 10pm.

During the removal of the acoustic shed, there will be periodic closures of the footpath on the eastern side of Burwood Road, between Parramatta Road and Burton Street **from Friday 13 December 2024**, during standard construction hours only. Traffic control will be in place to assist pedestrians around this work.
