31 October	 Very good practice by GLC at Clyde Dive: use of quiet electric tower crane at CLJ for OOH works, and substitution of warning lights instead of audible alarm for overhead load alert. No tones or other potentially annoying characteristics heard from crane. comprehensive consideration and treatment of potential noise issues associated with OOH grout deliveries, including: shipping container noise barrier; igloo screen and noise barrier; forward movement only of agi grout delivery trucks to eliminate reversing alarm noise; no signalling with horns; washout area located away from residences. Grout deliveries almost entirely inaudible at nearest residences. 		
1 October	[Reported previous month but repeated here because it occurred in October]: Spoil trucks operating on Hunter Street observed driving considerately, not using horns or engine brakes and with no obvious defects in manufacturer noise mitigation (eg exhaust mufflers).
