



Notification – Westmead

26 November 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

Temporary footpath closure - Hawkesbury Road (between Priddle and Bailey Streets)

Tunnelling contractor, GLC will adjust the pedestrian crossings at the intersection of Hawkesbury Road and Priddle Street during December 2024 (Stage 1) and early January 2025 (Stage 2).

Works will include widening crossings and pram ramps at the intersection. These improvements will increase the capacity for pedestrians and school children to cross at the intersection.

Stage 1 enabling works are planned to commence from **Tuesday 3 December to Saturday 14 December 2024** and will be carried out during standard construction hours from:

Monday to Friday - 7am to 6pm and Saturday - 8am to 6pm.

Work will involve:

- Setting up traffic control and a temporary lane and footpath closure on Hawkesbury Road between Bailey Street and Priddle Street during the day. The lane and footpath will be reopened at the end of shift each day.
- Saw cutting the footpath and excavating a trench to install conduits and power cables adjacent to the footpath.
- Replacing and relocating redundant overhead power lines and commissioning new power supply.
- Delivering and removing machinery, equipment, concrete and materials.
- Backfilling and restoring the footpath once works are complete.

Access to residential properties will be maintained during our work period.

To commission new power supply and remove redundant overhead power lines across the intersection, **two night shifts** will be required during December. Once approvals are in place, we will notify you again. For more information, please contact GLC's Community team on 1800 612 173.

Changes to traffic and pedestrian routes:

To facilitate access to work areas and safely operate machinery, there will be:

- Temporary lane and footpath closures on Hawkesbury Road between Bailey Street and Priddle Street to allow excavation on the footpath. See map below for pedestrian detour.
- Traffic control to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with changes to road and footpath conditions.

Access to public transport will be maintained.


