Project Update – Waterloo Over Station Development

January 2025

The Waterloo Metro Quarter is being completed by a joint venture between John Holland and Mirvac, the new Waterloo Metro Quarter will be a true mixed-use precinct combining residential apartments, social housing, affordable housing, student accommodation, retail, commercial spaces, a vibrant ground plane, community facilities and public open space.

Waterloo Metro Quarter commenced on the Basement and Southern Precinct in February 2023. This new destination will be a 'place to gather and grow' that embraces the diverse physical, social and cultural environment, and provides inclusive spaces that benefit everyone who visits.

Upcoming work in January around Waterloo Metro Quarter

Construction activity continues for the Over Station Development. An indicative work schedule for January is listed below. Standard construction hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 7.30am to 6pm.

- Delivering and removing equipment, large machinery, and materials.
- Scaffold installation and removal used for safe worker access.
- Structural steel installation and formwork for building structures.
- Tower crane operations and crane climbing from Wellington Street, Botany Road and Raglan Street work zones.
- Concrete pouring via pumps at Wellington Street, Botany Road and Raglan Street work zones. Concrete pours or finishing works may finish after 6:00pm and no later than 10:00pm Monday to Friday on a maximum of two occasions per calendar month.
- Facade installation and Internal fit-out for southern precinct buildings.
- Watermain Installation in Wellington Street & Botany Road
- Sewer Investigation Works in Wellington Street
- High Voltage and NBN/Telstra installation works on Wellington Street and Botany Road these works will involve intermittent road closures of Wellington Street between the hours 7am to 6pm
- Removal of site accommodation from Cope Street Plaza

Waterloo Station

Standard construction hours are Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 6pm. Wellington, Buckland, Raglan, Cope Streets, Henderson and Botany Road.

Utilities and defect rectification works internally and external to the station.

Upcoming out of hours work (OOHW) in January

Work taking place outside standard construction hours, Monday to Saturday from 6pm to 7am, and Sunday from 9pm.

Waterloo over station development

- Transportation or removal of vehicles, equipment, or materials.
- Watermain installation on Botany Road & Raglan Street
- Watermain installation/connection on the corner of Wellington Street & Botany
- Sewer Investigation Works in Wellington Street.

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
- Internal fit-out and services installations/commissioning up to 24 hours a day. (excluding Sunday and public holidays)
- Intermittent road closure of Wellington Street between the hours 8pm to 5am for utilities connections.

Waterloo Station

- Utilities and defect rectification works internally and external to the station.
- Facade installation and adjustment to Metro Station via Cope Street, works will include use of an EWP.

What to expect

- Equipment used will include, but is not limited to, hand-held and electric tools, jack-hammers, welders, power drills, excavators, compaction equipment, elevated work platforms, concrete trucks, concrete mixers and pumps, sweeper, cranes, light and heavy vehicles, pavement cutters, line marking grinder, vacuum trucks and asphalt compactors.
- Due to the nature of the work, nearby residents may be able to hear noise and feel
 vibration from some of the work. The project team will limit these impacts wherever
 possible. A range of mitigation measures are in place to meet the project's approval
 conditions and reduce noise, including turning off equipment when not in use and,
 where possible, equipping machinery with non-tonal movement alarms and using
 acoustic sheeting.
- Temporary traffic changes will be in place for the safety of workers and the community during this work, including reduced speed limits, removal of parking and footpath and lane closures.
- To complete some utility work, power or water outages may be required. These will be carried out at the direction of the utility company and any impacted residents will be notified.
