

Notification – Road Reinstatement Work

4 December 2024

Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, with a target travel time of about 20 minutes between the two centres.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West. John Holland CPB Contractors Ghella Joint Venture (JCG) has been awarded the contract to deliver 3.5 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Hunter Street CBD and excavate the Pyrmont and Hunter Street metro stations. JCG has established a construction site at The Bays in Rozelle and tunnelling activities are being carried out from this location.

Road Reinstatement Work – Port Access Road & Robert Street

JCG will be carrying out road work to reinstate a median strip and traffic island at the Port Access Road and Robert Street intersection, previously removed to facilitate oversized deliveries for the project.

Reinstatement work will occur between **Wednesday 11 December** and **Friday 20 December** from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 6pm on Saturdays**.

Work will include

- Establishing traffic control in the area to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers
- Removing existing asphalt, temporary median strip and traffic island
- Constructing a new median strip and traffic island
- Restoring the asphalt around the work area and signage.

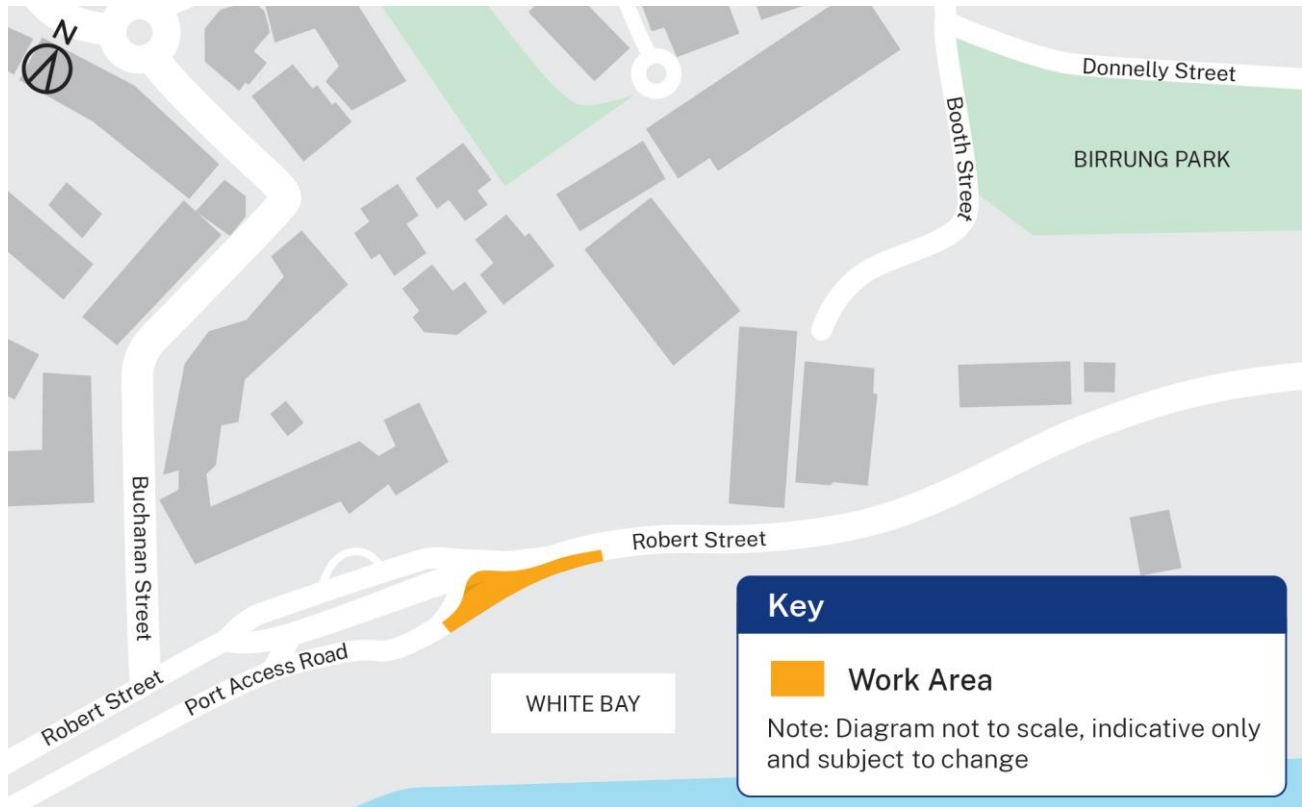
What to expect

- Temporary periods of high noise
- Increased activity including heavy vehicles and workers in this area
- Traffic control will be in place during this work to maintain traffic in both directions.

Equipment used

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to; excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete trucks, concreting equipment including a concrete vibrator, hand tools, temporary fencing, light vehicles, traffic control equipment and generators.
