Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Sydney Metro has been granted planning approval to construct twin underground rail tunnels between Westmead and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD for Sydney Metro West.

Acciona Ferroviaria Joint Venture (AFJV) has been awarded the contract to deliver 11 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Sydney Olympic Park and excavate five new metro stations, including a station at Five Dock

Out-of-hours work at Five Dock

AFJV will be finalising the road restoration works on Great North Road and Second Avenue **on Wednesday 29 January 2025 and Friday 7 February 2025 between 6pm and 5am** (weather and site conditions permitting). The following Tuesday 11 February 2025 will be the contingency date and notified separately, if required.

This work must occur outside standard construction hours due to road restrictions to minimise impacts on traffic and to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, workers, and local businesses.

The work will include:

- Setting up traffic control
- Utility and service locating and surveying
- Saw cutting sections of the footpath
- Using an excavator to hammer out sections of the footpath
- Restoring the impacted areas using concrete

What to expect:

- There will be noise associated with this work when cutting through the road
- Noise blankets will be used where possible to minimise disturbance
- Lighting will be directed to the work areas and away from residential properties

Changes to traffic, pedestrian and cyclist routes:

- Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with temporary changes at the work location
- There will be temporary footpath closures on Great North Road and Second Avenue
- Two-way traffic will be maintained at all times

Equipment used:

Equipment used for this work includes but is not limited to: surveying equipment, excavators, trucks, concrete vibrators, asphalt cutter, vibratory roller, road profiler, bobcats, jackhammer, compaction plates, paving machine, light vehicles, portable generator, lighting tower, hand tools and traffic control vehicles and signage.
