

# Notification – Clyde and surrounds

21 January 2025

## **Sydney Metro is Australia's biggest public transport project.**

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, transforming Sydney for generations to come.

This once-in-a-century infrastructure investment will provide fast, reliable turn-up-and-go metro services with fully accessible stations, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

Stations have been confirmed at Westmead, Parramatta, Sydney Olympic Park, North Strathfield, Burwood North, Five Dock, The Bays, Pyrmont and Hunter Street in the Sydney CBD. Two potential station locations are being investigated west of Sydney Olympic Park, including one at Rosehill Gardens which could support a significant increase in housing.

Gamuda Australia and Laing O'Rourke Consortium (GLC) has been awarded the contract to deliver nine kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between Westmead and Sydney Olympic Park, excavation for two new metro stations, a stabling and maintenance facility at Clyde and a precast facility at Eastern Creek.

## **Temporary road closures for Wentworth and Unwin Streets – late January to early February 2025**

To continue work on the Unwin Street realignment, sections of Wentworth and Unwin Streets will be closed to traffic at night and one weekend in February, pending weather and site conditions.

### **January 2025**

- 10pm Tuesday 28 January to 5am Wednesday 29 January 2025
- 10pm Wednesday 29 January to 5am Thursday 30 January 2025
- 10pm Thursday 30 January to 5am Friday 31 January 2025

### **February 2025**

- 8pm Saturday 1 February to 5am Monday 3 February 2025 – weekend road closure
- 10pm Monday 3 February to 5am Tuesday 4 February 2025
- 10pm Thursday 6 February to 5am Friday 7 February 2025
- 10pm Friday 7 February to 5am Saturday 8 February 2025

The planned road closures will be between the intersection of Wentworth and Martha Street and the intersection of Shirley and Unwin Street, see map overleaf for details.

**Entry and exit to the industrial area will only be via Grand Avenue from James Ruse Drive.**

**Detour from the intersection of Wentworth Street and Martha Street** - Vehicles travelling northbound on Wentworth Street will detour via Martha Street using Parramatta Road in both directions.

**Detour from the intersection of Unwin Street and Shirley Street** - Vehicles travelling westbound on Unwin Street will detour via Colquhoun Street and Grand Avenue to James Ruse Drive in both directions.

Traffic management and signage will be in place. Please keep to speed limits and follow the detours.

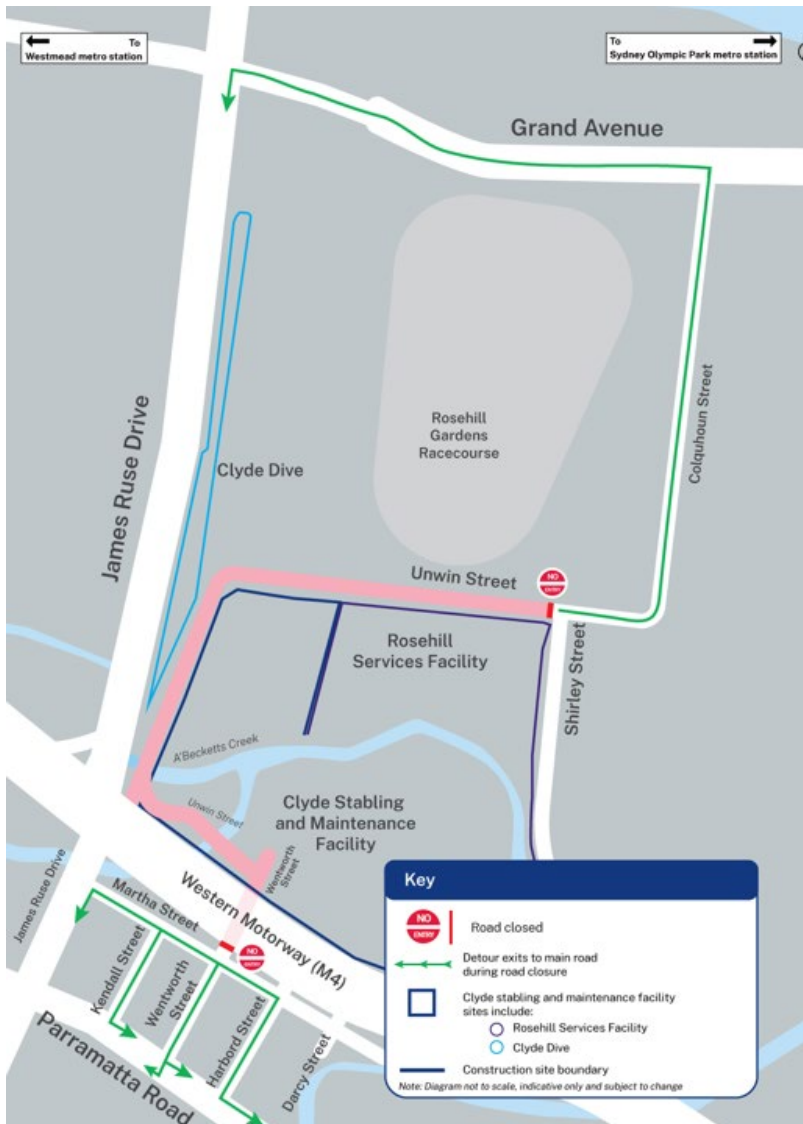
### **Works will involve:**

- Setting up traffic management, VMS signage and detours around the area.
- Completing minor road resurfacing, installing drainage, signage and laying asphalt.
- Removing road barriers, line marking and restoring the area once work is complete.

## What to expect

- Some activities will generate noise and this will be minimised as much as possible.
- Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained via traffic control on Wentworth and Unwin Streets.
- Traffic control and signage to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists with changes to traffic conditions will be in place, including boom gate operations, temporary barriers and pedestrian management.
- Allow extra time when travelling near these areas.
