

Notification – Temporary road and footpath changes - Hunter Street

14 February 2025

The NSW Government is delivering Sydney Metro West – a new underground metro railway which will double rail capacity between Parramatta and the Sydney CBD, link new communities to rail services and support employment growth and housing supply.

John Holland CPB Contractors Ghella Joint Venture (JCG) has been awarded the contract to deliver 3.5 kilometres of twin metro rail tunnels between The Bays and Hunter Street and to excavate the Pyrmont and Hunter Street metro stations.

Upcoming temporary road and footpath changes

As part of our work, we will be undertaking façade inspections of some buildings along Hunter Street, and along our site boundary using a high-definition drone. All buildings that require an inspection, have been contacted directly by JCG.

To complete this work safely, we will be implementing a 30-metre exclusion zone around the drone location, which will involve temporary traffic and pedestrian changes within the work area highlighted on the map over the page.

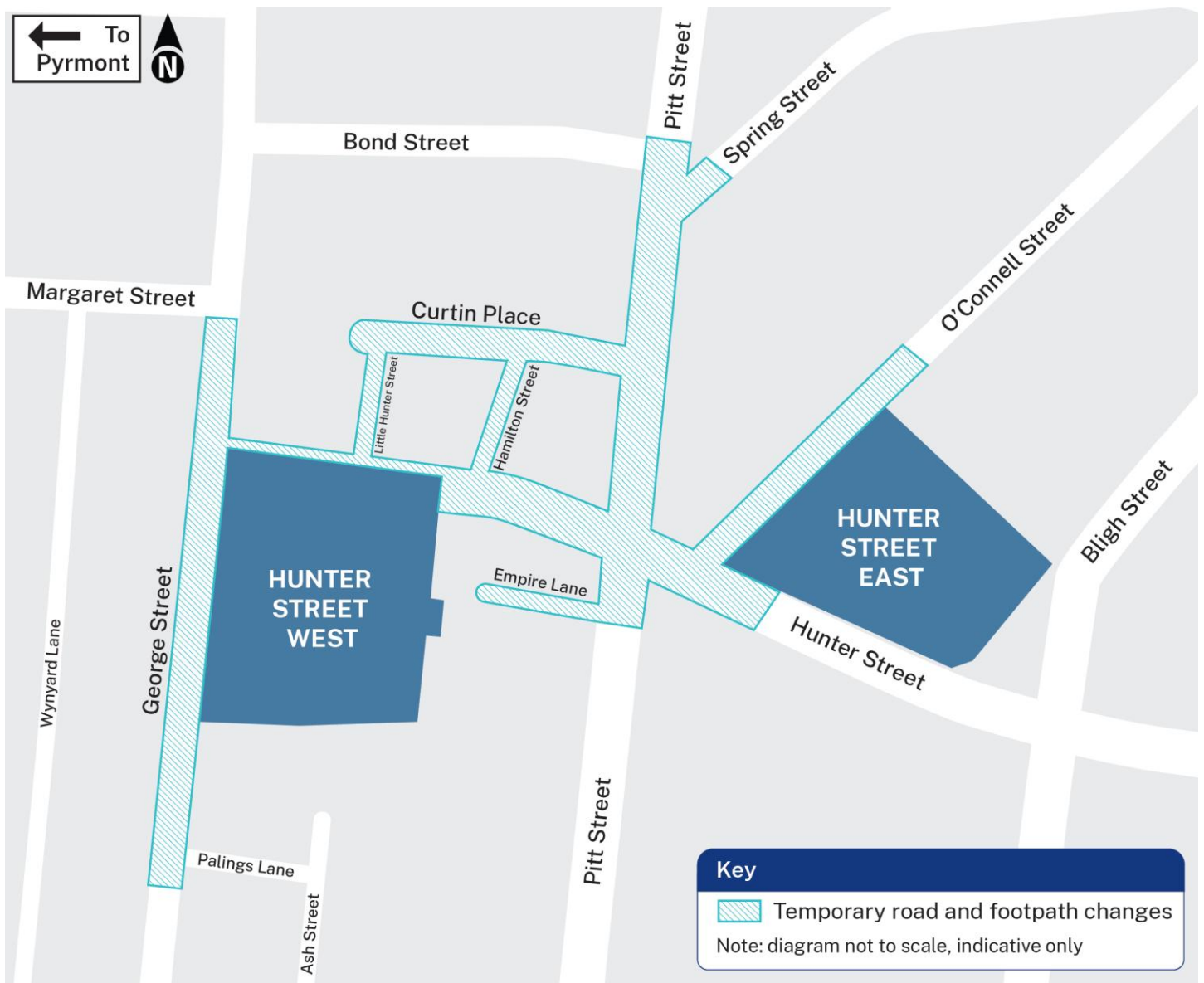
To minimise traffic and pedestrian impacts, this work will be carried out between **6am and 12pm on Sunday 23 February 2025**. A contingency shift between **6am and 12pm** is planned for **Sunday 2 March 2025** in case of poor weather.

While the drone is in operation, traffic and pedestrians will be stopped from entering the exclusion zone for a maximum of three minutes. Should there be no traffic or pedestrians, we would continue to maintain the exclusion zone, to reduce the length of time spent at each location. Exclusion zones will be managed by NSW Police and traffic controllers.

Work will include

- Operation of high-definition drone
- Presence of traffic management
- Temporary low volume noise from traffic control setup including reverse squawkers
- Temporary traffic impacts and parking removal
