## Upcoming temporary bridge closure – Melford Street overbridge, Hurlstone Park

## Weekend and night works - commencing Thursday 27 March 2025

To secure the corridor and safe operation of Metro trains, we are strengthening the existing rail overbridge barriers. Major traffic changes will be implemented while delivering and installing steel beams, including over sized equipment and lifting structures using cranes.

Temporary parking restrictions and detours will be in place during the day and at night from 7am Thursday 27 March until 5am Monday 31 March. Access will be changed for some residents and local access only will apply to Melford and Canberra streets and on the other side of the overbridge at Hurlstone Avenue and Hutton Street. The overbridge will be closed throughout the duration, including for pedestrians.

Parking removal is required on both sides of Melford Street in front of 120 and 124 Melford Street and between 59 and 63 Melford Street. Please park in an alternative parking space on Melford Street. Parking will also be removed on the corner of Canberra and Melford streets throughout the duration.

Work will be continuous across the weekend, however we will take breaks from noisier construction work.





**Deliveries may be noisy for short periods and will involve traffic controllers establishing signage and no parking areas, unhooking equipment, lights, and reversing beepers.** We will be using crane equipment, hand held powered tools, elevated work platforms, truck mounted crane, construction vehicles, over-sized trucks, delivery trucks, lighting towers and generators.

The team has carefully planned works to minimise impacts on local residents where possible, including working during the day where we can, maximising delivery time for the equipment and staging work to decrease commuter disruption. We will return to the Melford Street overbridge to install new screen barriers in June. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation while we complete these important works for the community.

During these periods, the overbridge will be closed to traffic in both directions, however local access will be managed through traffic control. All other commuters will be detoured around the overbridge. Speed limits will also be reduced to manage the traffic flow during the work period.
